Progression and Regression of Cirrhosis

Dr. Garcia-Tsao is a Professor of Medicine at the Yale University School of Medicine and Chief of the Section of Digestive Diseases at the Veterans Administration-Connecticut Health Care System. She is internationally recognized for her expertise in the pathophysiology and clinical manifestations of portal hypertension, and is a primary author of the AASLD guidelines for the management of GI bleeding in cirrhosis. Dr. Garcia-Tsao is a Past President of the AASLD and a member of the International Ascites Club and BAVENO Group. At the Yale Liver Center, she serves as Director of the Clinical and Translational Core.

Dr. Garcia-Tsao has authored more than 240 publications relevant to chronic liver disease and cirrhosis – including a 1-page “Liver Capsule” that appeared online in February 2017 on the pathogenesis and treatment of portal hypertension ([PMID 28032650](#)).
