

Request for Applications: Bissell Liver Scholar

The Liver Center invites UCSF trainees at all levels engaged in liver research to enter a competition for a one-time recognition award of \$10,000 along with the designation as a “Bissell Liver Scholar.” This prize is offered in honor of Dr. D. Montgomery (Monty) Bissell, a pioneer in the field of liver cell biology and former director of the UCSF Liver Center. Monty’s vision, enthusiasm and determination led to numerous advances in hepatology. His mentorship facilitated the success of scores of liver researchers.

The Bissell Liver Scholar Award is not a traditional research award. Instead, we ask applicants to craft an ambitious vision statement outlining how they hope to make an impact on the field of hepatology.

Application:	300-word statement of your vision for a high-impact basic or clinical research contribution advancing our understanding of liver biology and/or management of liver disease
